Vehicle Definition / Explanation

Residential: Accepted free of charge.

Commercial: Loads transported in a passenger vehicle, pickup truck, or trailer with two wheels and a single axle - Accepted free of charge.

A passenger vehicle is used to travel from one destination to another hauling primarily passengers.

A pickup truck is a light-duty truck having an enclosed cab and an open cargo area with low sides and tail/lift gate.

Commercial:

Other loads accepted at \$110/ton (2,000 lbs.) for Regular recyclables. Electronics can be recycled for \$1100/ton. (2000 lbs.)

A commercial vehicle is used to transport heavy goods and other things for commercial purposes.
