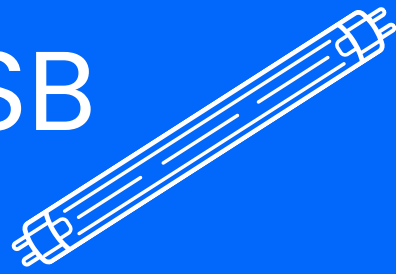




# Lightbulb Recycling in FNSB

## Quick and Easy Guide



Lightbulb Type	Recycling Location	Details
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• LED bulbs with plastic lenses</li> <li>• Holiday / string fixtures with plastic LED bulbs</li> <li>• LED tubes with plastic lenses</li> <li>• LED "tape" light</li> </ul>	<p><b>FNSB Central Recycling Facility (CRF):</b>  <b>1855 Marika Rd</b>  <b><u>907-374-6616</u></b>  <b>Mon-Fri 10-5:30 Sat 9-5</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cannot recycle Fluorescent fixtures here but electrical components can be recycled if removed. Ballasts marked as containing "no PCB's" can be recycled here as well.</li> <li>• No glass bulbs accepted</li> <li>• Holiday / string fixtures with glass bulbs need <b>glass bulbs removed</b> before going to CRF.</li> <li>• <u>Recycled for free</u></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Compact Fluorescent Bulbs</li> <li>• Fluorescent Glass Tubes (non shatterproof)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Green Star HQ</b>  <b>2134 Texaco Ave</b>  <b><u>907-452-4152</u></b>  <b>Mon- Fri 9-5 Sat 1-4</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We only take fluorescent bulbs, LED bulbs will break our bulb crusher as will shatterproof tubes</li> <li>• <u>All recycled for \$1 each</u></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Compact Fluorescent Bulbs</li> </ul>	<p><b>Home Depot</b>  <b>1301 Old Steese Hwy</b>  <b><u>(907) 451-9003</u></b>  <b>Mon-Sat 6-9 Sun 7-9</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Recycled for free</u>, ask for manager to get recycled</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Bulb types</li> </ul>	<p><b>Republic Services</b>  <b>1315 Queens Way</b>  <b><u>907-328-7025</u></b>  <b>Mon-Fri 8-5</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Includes HID bulbs like Metal Halide, High Pressure Sodium, Mercury Vapor etc.</li> <li>• <u>Most bulbs recycled for \$8.55 per pound</u></li> <li>• <u>Fluorescent Tubes recycled for \$3.15 each</u></li> </ul>



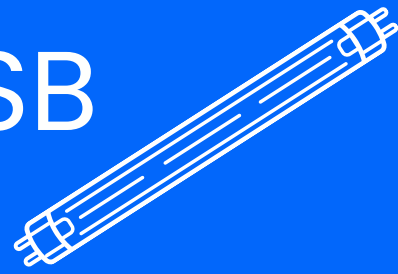

<b>FNSB Central Recycling Facility (CRF):</b> <b>1855 Marika Rd</b> <b>907-374-6616</b> <b>Mon-Fri 10-5:30 Sat 9-5</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Holiday/string lights with plastic bulbs</li> <li>• Plastic lens LED bulbs and tubes</li> <li>• All recycled for free</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cannot recycle Florescent fixtures here but electrical components can be recycled if removed as well as the ballast's marked as containing "no PCB's"</li> <li>• Holiday / string lights with glass bulbs need glass bulbs removed before going to CRF.</li> </ul>
<b>Green Star HQ</b> <b>2134 Texaco Ave</b> <b>907-452-4152</b> <b>Mon- Fri 9-5 Sat 1-4</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Compact Fluorescent</li> <li>• Fluorescent glass tubes (non shatterproof )</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• LED bulbs are not recycled the same as fluorescent. We only take fluorescent bulbs, LED bulbs will break our equipment.</li> <li>• All recycled for \$1 each.</li> </ul>

<b>Home Depot</b> <b>1301 Old Steese Hwy</b> <b>(907) 451-9003</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Compact Florescent</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recycled for free, ask for manager to get recycled</li> </ul>
<b>Republic Services</b> <b>1315 Queens Way</b> <b>(833) 246-3367</b> <b>Mon-Fri 8-5</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All light bulb types</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HID bulbs are bulbs like Metal Halide, High Pressure Sodium, Mercury Vapor etc.</li> <li>• Recycled for \$8.50 per pound</li> </ul>
